## LOT 620

A silver and gold, ruby and diamond brooch, the central oval cut ruby within a petal shaped surround between scroll sides, mounted with circular cut diamonds, width 4.5cm, ruby weight approx 4.00ct, total diamond weight approx 2.00ct.

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## Condition Report

620. The ruby is of medium to dark colour saturation and has very limited translucency. It is possible that the ruby has been treated in the past. The diamonds slightly draw colour and many are showing a few internal inclusions and a degree of fluorescence. The brooch is fairly modern, being a reproduction of a Victorian inspired design. Cut: old European cut diamonds and faceted cut ruby. Colour: deep red ruby, the diamonds approx I-J on average. Clarity: ruby has inclusions visible to the unaided eye, the diamonds approx SI1-SI2 on average. The total diamond weight is approx 2ct. Weight 9.3g.
