## LOT 638

A diamond brooch in a pierced design, centred by the principal cushion shaped diamond between diamond set foliate sides, mounted with smaller cushion shaped and rose cut diamonds, circa 1910, width 4.5cm.

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## Condition Report

638. The diamonds slightly draw colour and some have a few internal inclusions. There is evidence of past restoration to the brooch when viewed from the back. There is a crack visible from back and front connecting the central section to the beginning of the foliate line on one side. The brooch pin is bent by the hinge and the front of the brooch appears to be slightly distorted. It is otherwise in fair condition. Weight 3.2g.

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
