A Bulle Patent electric mantel timepiece, circa 1930s, the silvered circular dial with black Arabic numerals and inscribed 'Bulle Patent', the movement detailed '270458' and 'Bulle-Clock France', on a walnut circular base, the cut glass dome with foliate decoration, total height 36.5cm.

## Condition Report

Glass dome in good condition with no cracks or chips. The base with original string seal, is in good condition with only some minor scratches. Modern, plastic battery compartment fitted under the base.

All mechanism parts seem to be there.

The original fabric suspension has rotted and no longer supports the pendulum. This has caused the circular spring to distort. Dial and hands in good condition.

Cannot be tested to see if working but it is our belief that if the faults were attended to and a suitable battery fitted this clock would, we think, run.
