### LOT 1055

A Jaeger-LeCoultre Automatic gold gentleman's bracelet wristwatch, the signed gilt dial with gilt baton numerals, date-of-the-month aperture and centre seconds, on a tapering woven mess link bracelet, the fold-over clasp detailed '0.375', case diameter 3.3cm, with a later associated case.

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### Condition Report

1055.

Overall the watch is in generally good order. The bracelet is also 9ct gold but does have some condition issues such as broken links near to lugs to the extent its almost completely split and generally weak. Bracelet has no Jaeger-LeCoultre marks. We were unable to get the back off the watch. Bracelet heads look like they are soldered to lugs as cannot detach it. Marked 9ct. Clasp works.

Winder has logo, it winds smoothly, adjusts and runs but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch. Case has typical light surface scratches but no significant damage or dents.
