A Wedgwood type black basalt teapot and cover, 19th century, naturalistically modelled as a tree trunk decorated with fruiting vine, unmarked, height 15cm (minor chips), together with a similar coffee pot and cover and sugar bowl and cover, each with engine turned decoration, and a Wedgwood circular bowl, diameter 18.7cm.

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

1463. Sugar bowl - bowl with small chip to rim edge exterior and 2cm long scratch to exterior decoration. 2 chips to underside rim edge of cover.

Bowl - in good condition.

Teapot - tip of spout chipped with signs of old restoration. Small chip to upper rim edge near handle. Chip to inner flange of cover and small nicks/chips to edge of cover.

Coffee - in good condition.
