A good set of twelve Copeland porcelain cabinet plates, circa 1873, each enamelled in low relief Limoges style with flower specimens against an eau-de-Nil ground, within bleu céleste borders heightened with gilded and enamelled stylized fleur-de-lys and scroll motifs, edged in gilding, blue printed and impressed marks to bases with red painted pattern No. 'D9430', diameter 24cm.

### Condition Report

1570. Overall the plates are in very good condition with no chips, cracks or repairs. The gilding remains bright and strong with no real wear, and the enamels similarly. The bleu celeste borders display some minor blemishes on very close inspection and the wild rose plate has a 1cm long scratch to the eau-de-Nil ground at 8 o'clock.
