LOT 2005

A Regency mahogany console table, in the manner of Thomas Hope, the shaped panel back finely carved with scrolls and palmettes above an inverted breakfront top and three frieze drawers, raised on four carved acanthus leaf scrolling supports with claw terminals, the plinth base with a border of stiff leaves, height 94cm, width 190cm, depth 52cm (faults including one broken support).

Estimate: £400 - £600

Condition Report

2005. The console table has been cut down the centre on the top and base section, so therefore, it must have been reduced in width at some stage. This would perhaps mean that the back panel has possibly been matched to fit the reduced width. There is one small section of moulding missing on a corner of the frieze and there is a crack across the back edge of the base. One of the claw feet has been broken. Overall surface marks and scratches, as well as a few minor chips to carved edges.
