A George III silver four egg cruet stand of shaped square form with a central circular salt with overhead handle, on ball feet, fitted with four egg cups, London 1799 by Lewis Pantin III, height 17cm, together with a set of four Victorian silver egg spoons, London 1852.

Condition Report

370. Generally good condition. The frame is in generally good order. It is slightly misshapen so does not sit entirely flat. Typical surface wear and scratches. Gilt to salt has some wear. Few minor solder repairs to top section of frame, particularly where rings meet the foot of the central salt. There are simple repairs where it has become slightly detached. Good clear hallmarks.

All four egg cups are matching with matching hallmarks. Typical wear and surface scratches and wear to gilt interiors.

Set of four later matched spoons in good condition with clear hallmarks. Possible erasures to initials/crest to tops of spoons.
