A late 19th century Continental gilt metal posy holder of pierced and embossed foliate form, fitted with an oval mirror above a turned mother-of-pearl handle, length 15cm, together with a late 19th century gilt bronze example.

Condition Report

2441. The mirrored holder would have had some painted detail but much of this is worn off. The link between the main basket and the stem is quite delicate and slightly torn. Some dents to the top of the basket and a nicely distressed mirror panel. Missing a chain to the bottom of the handle. The other piece is in generally good order with some minor surface wear.
