An early 20th century ivory silk and lace wedding dress, a pair of ivory silk lady's shoes, veil, shawls and other associated wedding clothing and accessories, all related to the marriage of Dorothy Helen Hodges and Captain E.G. Gidley-Kitchin, together with related paperwork.

Condition Report

2832 - The dress itself is in fair condition with only some minor wear, a few loose threads and some pulled appliques on the net hangings. The lace headpiece is in good condition and the shoes have only some minor browning to the silk. The plain net veil has numerous small holes throughout, 160 x 140cm. The small panel with single edge of embroidered flowers is slightly browned but otherwise ok. 90 x 64cm. The triangular shaped shoulder piece is stained and quite badly held in places.

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
