A Derby porcelain allegorical figure of America, circa 1750-80, modelled as a Native American with a feather headdress and bow and arrow, standing on an alligator, raised on a naturalistic base, incised 'No. 20' to base, height 16cm (minor faults).

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

1527 - In generally good condition. There is a typical firing crack where the legs join the base. There is half a feather missing on the headdress and the arrow on the back has broken off and is not present. There are a number of chips and losses to the leaf decoration to the base and a chip to the alligator mouth.
