A set of six Royal Crown Derby coffee cups and saucers, circa 1898-1903, each decorated in the Imari palette with floral sprays and a scrolling border, red mark to base including pattern number '2649', saucer diameter 11.5cm, together with a small group of other Royal Crown Derby and similar wares, including a four-piece Davenport teaset, comprising teapot, stand, sugar bowl and milk jug (some faults)

1521. 2649 set of 6 - small chips to rim of one cup, otherwise all cups and saucers in good condition, minor light wear to gilt rims of cups.

One 383 pattern can with large chip.

One 383 pattern saucer with large chip.

Witches pattern teacup and saucer - saucer crazed, cup with badly glued handle and crack.

1128 pattern vase and cover - cover badly damaged and glued with missing section.

Stand - badly damaged with glued and riveted repairs.

Teapot stand - crazed and chipped.

Davenport sugar bowl with plated rim - rim mounts loose, otherwise ok.

Remaining items in lot in good condition.
