Condition Report

1602. There are a number of long typical craze lines to the figure amidst the glaze, eg around neck, some to the bottom right edge of the wings appear to have been stabilised with some restoration, another to the back of the wings has a tiny enamel flake over it. The whole of the left arm including the tip of the wing it is holding has been restored. Missing butterfly from top of hat. Haircracks to 2 front corners of base.
