### LOT 1545

A Chamberlain porcelain yellow ground Princess Charlotte's shape trio, circa 1816, enamelled with flowers and with eagle's head handles, unmarked, a Chamberlain New Gadroon Tournay shape coffee cup and saucer, enamelled with floral sprays against a gilt overlaid cobalt blue ground, iron red painted mark to saucer, and a group of other mostly 19th century English porcelain, including a spill vase painted with a view of Derbyshire (basket restored).

### Condition Report

1545. Trio - good condition, light crazing, no chips, cracks or repairs, typical light wear to gilt and light surface scratches.

Chamberlain cup and saucer - cup in good condition with no chips, cracks or repairs. Saucer with faint small hairline to rim (approx 2.5cm long), otherwise both with light crazing and typical light wear to gilt and minor surface scratches.

2899 pattern trio - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs, minor wear to gilt.

Blue & floral trio - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs, typical wear to enamels and gilt.
