A small group of Royal Worcester porcelain wares, including a cup and saucer, circa 1901, each painted with a floral spray and a panel depicting animals against a blush ivory ground, diameter of saucer 14cm, a slender jug and two miniature pots and covers (some faults).

Condition Report

Jug - good condition. No chips, cracks or restoration. Minor wear to gilt.

Gadrooned edge up and saucer - good condition, some wear to gilt rims. No chips, cracks or restoration

Two cups and saucer - Good condition - no chips, cracks or restoration. Bit dirty and dusty and wear to gilt rims

Two matching side plates - good condition - no chips, cracks or restoration. Wear to gilt, one rim badly worn

Robin pot and cover - small hairline to rim of pot, otherwise ok, cover in good order

Blush pot and cover - good condition, minor wear to gilt
