Twelve Chinese glass paperweights, early to mid-20th century, including a large patterned millefiori example, diameter 10cm, an egg shaped example with fish and a white ground example, decorated with a portrait of John F. Kennedy within a millefiori border, diameter 9cm (minor faults).

Condition Report

1759. Single pink flower - bruise to side.
Single blue flower - bruise to footrim.
Large millefiori - 5 bruises to side of dome.
Single turquoise flower - small bruise to side.
Large pink waterlily - some bruises to side.
Orange waterlily - bruise to dome.
Relief leafwork - tip of dome repaired.
Remaining items in generally good order with typical minor wear.
