Condition Report

1547. Hunt saucer - some minor crazing to one part of rim.

Trio - vertical haircrack to cup, saucer and plate finely crazed, restoration to saucer and small chip to footrim.

Pin dish - small chips to rubbed gilt rim.

Vase - vertical haircrack to neck.

Remaining items in good condition.
