A Japanese silk embroidered wall hanging, Meiji period, worked in coloured threads with a scene of three red capped cranes flying amidst blossoming branches with chrysanthemums and daisies below, on a purple ground, $227 \text{cm} \times 172 \text{cm}$.

Condition Report

1240. Overall in good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Colours are good and vibrant. Few minor patches/spots of staining to lower left corner, but nothing obviously noticeable. 3.5cm stitched tear repair to upper right corner. Very minor unstitching to lower crane's left leg. Typical light wear to edges with some minor creasing and crinkles. Pale blue backing is worn in places particularly edges with some losses.
