### LOT 1284

A small group of Chinese Jun type stoneware, comprising a baluster vase, height 16.5cm, two conical bowls, diameters 18cm and 18.7cm, a spittoon/cuspidor, height 12.8cm, and a small conical bowl, diameter 9.8cm (minor faults).

Estimate: £200 - £400

### Condition Report

1284. Baluster vase - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs. All-over light crazing and some pitting to glaze. Some light yellow discolouring to crazing.

Paler blue conical bowl - small shallow chip to footrim (0.9cm x 0.6cm), otherwise bowl is in generally good condition with no cracks or repairs. All-over crazing/crackle to glaze with some yellow/brown staining to the crazing/crackle.

Darker blue conical bowl - some chips to the footrim, otherwise bowl is in generally good condition with no apparent cracks or restoration. The glaze to exterior and particularly interior has typical wear and scratches as well as some pitting and areas of roughness visible in online photographs.

Spittoon /cuspidor - small shallow chip to rim (0.8cm x 0.3cm), otherwise in good condition with no other chips, cracks or repairs. All-over light crazing with some light staining. Typical surface wear and scratches to glaze.

Small bowl - broken section of footrim has been re-glued (approx 3cm x 1cm), otherwise bowl in generally good order. No chips or cracks. Glaze interior is good. Typical light surface wear and scratches.
