LOT 2165

A 19th century burr yew and mahogany crossbanded side cabinet, possibly Irish, the double concave front fitted with a pair of doors, raised on carved hairy paw feet, height 97cm, width 124cm, depth 42cm (faults and restoration).

Estimate: £200 - £300

Condition Report

2165. General condition is reasonably good, however the front of the cabinet has had overall painted surface retouching that now can be seen clearly. This is mainly the darker areas down the centre of the cabinet and in most part doesn't really seem to be covering anything at all. There is a crack to the left lower corner and some small areas of loss to the crossbanding around the lower edge below left door. Also a small crack to the centre point of the cabinet. The carved legs appear to be later additions but the rest of the cabinet appears to be of the same period.
