A gold, diamond and ruby set ring, designed as a coiled snake, the head mounted with three cushion shaped diamonds and ruby set eyes, ring size approx M.

### Condition Report

586. The diamonds slightly draw colour to grey. There is very minor surface wear to the table facet edges of the ruby eyes. The ring shank has a few dents and small scratches. There is otherwise uniform surface wear and also an acid test stain indicating high grade gold. Circa 1900. Cut: old European cut diamonds. Colour: approx G-H. The florescence of the stones is faint. Clarity: VS2-SI1. The total diamond weight approx 0.06-0.08ct. Weight 6.3g. Circa 1900.
