An early 20th century ebony and brass mounted folding conductor's baton, the handle and tip with engraved decoration, length 52cm, the black leather case detailed 'J. Heron, Jeweller, Blyth', together with two other cased batons, one with a Japanese ivory and Shibayama inlaid handle, and a spare case.

Condition Report

2601. The ebonized folding baton has some minor rubbing to the tip but is generally in good order. The Japanese handled baton could have possibly been made-up at a slightly later date, the handle probably originally being a cutlery handle. The tip is slightly loose. The other baton is ivory and is dated 1904. However, it is missing its handle mount and has been drilled multiple times along the shaft.
