A Worcester porcelain large coffee or chocolate cup, circa 1765-70, probably decorated in the James Giles workshop, of typical 'U' shape with grooved loop handle gilt with husks, the main body enamelled with a large Fancy Bird on rockwork accompanied by a smaller bird on a branch, a similar bird in flight to the reverse, beneath a gilded rim, underglaze blue pseudo Meissen mark to base, height 7.5cm (minor gilding loss to rim). Note: a similar cup was sold by Bonhams in their Fine English Porcelain & Glass auction, 9th March 2005, Lot 56.

Condition Report

1454. In good condition overall with no chips, cracks or repairs. Two small spots of gilding loss to rim, each approx 0.5cm long, where pitted surface of body beneath is visible. Otherwise gilding and enamels good.
