A Roman pale green glass bowl, probably 2nd to 4th century AD, with ribbed decoration, raised on a circular foot, diameter 9.2cm, together with two similar conical shaped glasses, one green tinted, the other amethyst tinted, heights 9.5cm and 8.9cm.

Condition Report

1687. Bowl - the glass bowl is intact and in good condition. It was consigned by the widow of a local collector. Green glass - in good condition, no real signs of wear to base.

Amethyst glass - starcrack to bowl near rim where there is an inclusion in the glass body. Area of scratches to bowl exterior. No real signs of wear to base.
