A Continental Meissen style white glazed porcelain figure group of The Polish Kiss, 19th century, modelled after Kändler, as a gentleman leaning to kiss the hand of a seated lady, a dog at her feet, raised on a base applied with flowers and foliage, unmarked, height 16cm (some faults and restoration).

Estimate: £40 - £60

Condition Report

1415. Large firing crack runs from the middle of the base underside, over the front middle edge behind the dog and into the bocage on the rockwork. As similar smaller firing crack is at one end of the group and a fine haircrack is visible to the base underside. Typical losses to applied flowers and foliage. Dog missing tail since manufacture. Restoration to hands and his sword. No marks and obviously a factory second.
