Condition Report

2011. Action seems to operate ok if not a little bit stiff. General condition is ok with an area of surface carving missing to the front edge of one foot. Small section of veneer missing on one leg and a few areas of slight lifting to the veneer around feet. Otherwise sear and fraying to the seat.
