A Chinese blue and white porcelain ginger jar, Kangxi period, the stout ovoid body painted with three barbed panels of Buddhist lions in a fenced garden, reserved against a prunus and cracked ice ground, height 21cm.

## Condition Report

1170. Overall very good clean condition. Typical light surface wear and scratches to glaze. Only condition issue is a very faint star crack to centre of one panel which is only really detectable under a UV lamp. Very minor glaze loss just above footrim, but this looks to have been in the manufacturing process.
