An early 19th century gold and garnet set five stone ring, mounted with a row of oval cut garnets graduating in size to the centre stone, the mount in a bead and ropetwist wirework cannatile style design, ring size approx P, with a case.

Estimate: £200 - £300

Condition Report

509. There is minor surface wear to the garnets, otherwise the ring is in good condition. Typical light surface scratches but no surface reaching fractures to any of the stones. No marks at all.

The velvet lining of the heart shaped box is loose and the exterior is scuffed to the edges. The hinge is in good condition. Weight 2.6g.

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
