### LOT 605

A gold marquise shaped ring, glazed with a locket compartment within an engraved border, ring size approx N1/2, a gold, seed pearl and blue enameled oval clasp, circa 1800, glazed with a seed pearl monogram on a blue enameled ground within a surround of half-pearls (one half-pearl lacking), and a gold ring, mounted with a central circular cut ruby between two cultured pearls, ring size approx J1/2.

Estimate: £200 - £300

### Condition Report

605. Marquise ring – is in good condition and has no inscription when viewed from the back. The original hair locket has been removed.

Oval clasp – the tongue of the clasp which would have pushed in is missing and the glazing to the seed pearl locket is rather scratched. The half pearl set border has an attractive silvery lustre, though note that one pearl is lacking.

Ruby and cultured pearl ring – the ruby is of medium colour saturation. The two cultured pearls have an attractive silvery lustre and the shank is detailed indistinctly '18K'.

Total weight 19.6g.

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
