A garnet, marcasite, green stained agate and freshwater pearl brooch in a rococo pierced design, probably Austro-Hungarian, length 7.7cm.

Condition Report

626. The suggested age of the brooch is circa 1920. The connecting chains either side of the principal drop have largely been broken away, this drop is held to the centre of the bottom of the top section by a single loop. The brooch pin has possibly been later added. There is evidence of loops at the top of the back from where the pendant would have originally been connected to a neckchain. The principal drop has probably been reconstructed in the past.

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
