A Clement Massier Art Nouveau pottery jardinière stand, late 19th century, the openwork design formed from four vertical stylized palm fronds beneath a petal shaped top, raised on a pierced base with naturalistic moulded foliate detail, covered in a turquoise glaze with brown glazed detail to the base, impressed mark to base edge, height 67cm (faults and repairs).

Estimate: £50 - £80

Condition Report

1451. Overall heavily crazed with surface wear. Approx 2cm long chip to underside rim edge with remnants of old paint. Minor glaze abrasions to moulded detail only noticeable on close inspection. Approx 3cm by 2cm glaze chip to edge of foot. Approx 1/4 section of foot broken away in one large piece with visible repairs. Fundamentally all the pieces are present apart from some minor glaze loss and the stand could be professionally restored successfully.
