A 19th century Japanese carved stone temple lantern of hexagonal form, the domed top above a candle enclosure, raised on a cylindrical stem and hexagonal base, height 170cm.

## Condition Report

2662. There is substantial surface damage to one edge of the hexagonal apron section below the candle holder. Also loss to the collar half way up the column. Otherwise overall surface wear to edges and corners and an overall weathering to the surface. All joints have been cemented together but the top is loose at present.
