366. Bell works and rings when finial is turned rather than pushed. Silver in generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Typical light surface wear and scratches and a few dents mostly to the top. Good clear hallmarks. Ebonized base ok with no damage or repair, but some wear to ebonizing.
