### LOT 1511

A large Ernst Wahliss Austrian porcelain two-handled vase, circa 1900, the blush ground pear shaped body decorated with gilt enriched flowers beneath the cobalt blue angular handles, red printed mark to base, height 40cm, together with a small group of other ceramics, including a framed plaque and a set of six English porcelain plates (faults).

Estimate: £60 - £100

### Condition Report

1511. Ernst Wahliss - some surface scratches to body, otherwise ok.

Framed plaque - slightly loose in frame, minor wear.

Floral encrusted vase - typical losses to flowers and leaves.

Floral plates x 6 - four crazed, one of these with hairline and chip to underside of rim.

Lustre bowl - wear to interior/exterior crazed.

Jar and cover - heavily discoloured and crazed, hairline crack to jar, chips to the edge.

Other pieces in good condition.
