A Victorian gold and lapis lazuli circular brooch, circa 1870, mounted with a large lapis lazuli bead centred by a diamond set five pointed star, framed by an openwork buckle and strap surround, set with rose cut diamonds, the back glazed with a locket compartment, diameter 3.5cm, fitted with a safety chain, with a case.

Condition Report

503. Overall good condition. The lapis stone has a few internal hairlines which are only really visible under magnification, otherwise the mount is in good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Case has typical scuffs and wear, but generally good order.

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
