Baton bracelet - good condition. Typical light wear and very minor chips to facets.

2 ring brooches - good condition, some wear to mounts.

Larger banded agate ring brooch with ropetwist mount - cracked and wear to mounts.

Rectangular brooch - good condition.

Thistle brooch - good condition.

Aye brooch - good condition.

Cross pendant - good condition, some wear.

2 circular brooches - repairs to stones.
