A Chinese carved giltwood six-armed Buddha on stand, Qing dynasty, modelled seated on a lotus throne with mandala behind, on a hexagonal galleried stand, carved in relief with trellis, height 54cm (one arm missing and other faults).

Condition Report

1150. Tip of mandarla is chipped and missing, vertical splits to mandarla. One hand missing to back right arm, other repairs to arms. Some attributes which would have been in Buddha's hands are missing. Significant loss, chips and wear to gilt, gesso and wood, but still a good decorative piece.
