### Condition Report

1212. Larger panel - in good condition with no apparent damage or repairs. Few tiny spots of discolouration, but nothing of consequence. Colours are vibrant. Frame is good with few minor scuffs/nicks.

Waterfall panel - has a number of small worm holes most at the base/pool of the waterfall and a few up the left side of the image. Otherwise good condition with good vibrant colours. Frame in good order.
