A Continental porcelain Samson type Worcester style plate, late 19th century, painted with exotic birds and insects within gilt framing against a blue scale ground, unmarked, diameter 25cm, together with a group of other ceramics, comprising two Derby bough pots and one cover, a floral painted Staffordshire dish, a Chinese saucer and a Derby vase, height 17.5cm (faults, repairs and restoration).

Estimate: £60 - £100

Condition Report

1520. Chinese saucer - chip to rim at 2 o'clock, minor enamel losses.

Plate - minor losses to gilt decoration.

Oval dish - chip to rim at 3 o'clock, scratches to interior, gilding rubbed.

Vase - star crack on left side of body, discoloured, crazed, right handle restored, other hairlines to body and rim.

Bloor Derby bough pot & cover - rivet repaired to left side, large area of restoration to front right side which is poorly done, lid hairline cracked, heavy gilt wear.

Other bough pot - rivet repaired, running from left to right and sides to base. Chips to two feet.
