A Barr Worcester porcelain armorial cup and saucer, circa 1800, the yellow ground overlaid in gilt with scrolling flowers and foliage around a dove and snake armorial, incised 'B' to base of cup, two Davenport coffee cans and saucers, a Staffordshire chamberstick and three pieces of New Hall, pattern No. 311 (minor faults).

Estimate: £50 - £100

Condition Report

1403. Worcester armorial cup & saucer - saucer decoration rubbed and losses to gilding, small chip to exterior rim. Cup scratched to interior bowl.

Green Davenport cup and saucer - minor losses to gilding, saucer with hairline crack at approx 3 and 9 o'clock running into the centre.

Blue Davenport cup & saucer - minor losses to gilding, particularly to centre of saucer.

New Hall trio - typical scratching to bowl/saucer interiors.

Chamberstick - approx 1.5cm piece missing from sconce rim, crazed, discolouration to underside.
