A pair of Derby porcelain ormolu mounted candelabra figures, late 18th century, modelled as a lady holding her skirt and a gentleman before bocado, a hat at his feet, each on a scroll moulded base picked out in pink enamel and gilding, mounted on rococo ormolu bases with foliate scrollwork, beneath three scroll arm foliate sconces with removable nozzles, height 29cm (minor restoration).

Derby gentleman - left hand restored, some typical heavy losses to floral bocado, chipped bow to right leg.
