A 19th century cello with single piece back, bearing indistinct number stamped to end of fingerboard, length of back excluding button 75cm, together with two nickel mounted bows, within a hard case.

Condition Report

2660. The surface of the varnish has an overall craquelure and the body has overall minor scuffs, wear and scratches. There is a small crack to the right-hand edge of front side and a small crack running up from the lower lobe of the right 'f' hole. There are some cracks to both sides. There is a repair around the button and the peg box appears to have had machined heads removed leaving marks and small filled holes to the sides. No label inside. In our opinion there does not seem to be any signs of woodworm.
