Condition Report

678. The piece is in generally good condition as it does not appear to have had any real wear. No significant damage or repairs and only typical light surface scratches. Marks are good and clear. These show the natural inclusions to some of the larger stones and also how the lapis head of the beetle was carved and set in sections.

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
