An Edwardian Arts and Crafts oak framed hall chair, attributed to E.G. Punnett, the arched top rail inlaid with three stylized flowers above an upholstered panel and shaped wing sides, the inset rush seat raised on block supports, the rear leg supports pierced with heart motifs, height 101cm, width 53cm, depth 45cm.

Condition Report

4001. Good overall appearance and condition, having had a few honest repairs. The rear top edge of one side has been repaired and had three screws to hold it in place. Also there are a few cracks to the small protruding sections of the shaped leg brackets and one is a later replacement. Some light wear to seat rails.
