A rare pair of H.M. Williamsons Women's Social & Political Union bone china trios, early 20th century, each comprising teacup, saucer and plate, transfer printed with the 'Angel of Freedom' crest in the suffragette colours of purple, white and green, within green painted rims, printed mark to bases, diameter of plates 17.5cm (both cups with hairline cracks).

Estimate: £300 - £500

Condition Report

1405. 1st cup - two vertical haircracks to rim, approx 1.5cm and 2cm.

2nd cup - one vertical haircrack to rim, approx 2cm.

One saucer - manufacturer's firing crack to rim by emblem, approx 0.7cm

Otherwise the trios are in good condition with no chips, cracks or repairs. They have obviously been used as they display wear. The plates in particular have surface scratches/knife cuts visible when angled in the light. Very minor wear to the decoration overall.
