An Art Deco Lalique opalescent glass Perruches pattern bowl, circa 1931, the exterior moulded with a continuous band of budgerigars amongst foliage against a blue stained ground, acid etched 'R. Lalique France' to base, diameter 23.2cm (rim reduced).

Estimate: £300 - £500

Condition Report

1605. The top rim of the bowl has been reduced/polished to eliminate some damage that had occurred previously - we suggest this as the heads of the budgerigars are very close to the rim and this distance varies around the bowl circumference. Some very small nicks remain to the bowl rim circumference which are only really noticeable on close inspection. Otherwise the bowl is in good condition with surface scratches to the base interior and underside.
