## LOT 707

A gold brooch, mounted with the principal oval cut amethyst within a surround of half-pearls and a border of small amethysts, width 2.8cm (one half-pearl lacking), and a Victorian brooch of shaped oval form, glazed with a feathered hairwork spray within a scrolling surround, width 4.8cm.

Estimate: £80 - £120

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## Condition Report

707. Amethyst brooch – the principal amethyst is of medium colour saturation, the surrounding small amethysts are a little paler. One pearl is missing from the border. The brooch is in otherwise good condition. Weight 8.8g.

Victorian brooch – the surrounding mount to the central glazed hair locket compartment has numerous old repairs and when viewed from the side looks to be rather distorted. The bracket to hold the hinge pin also has an unsightly repair. From the front there are also piercings and cracks to the outer border of the brooch. Weight 13.8g.

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
