A Victorian enamelled mourning brooch, glazed with a central feathered hairwork locket compartment, width 4.4cm, and a Victorian black enamelled and half-pearl set shaped oval mourning brooch, glazed with a central woven hair locket compartment within a surround of seed pearls, width 6cm.

Condition Report

708. Brooch one – the central glazing is a little loose and has a small chip to the rim. The enamelled surround has one or two small surface nicks and chips. Overall the brooch is a little dirty and would benefit from professional cleaning. There are also one or two shallow dents to the back.

Brooch two – the pearls have an attractive silvery lustre. The central glazed locket compartment in is good condition, though the central section of locket is a little loose. The enamel is in good condition. The hinge pin needs pushing in. Otherwise the brooch would benefit from professional cleaning.
