### LOT 728

A gold foil backed topaz and seed pearl set drop shaped pendant, circa 1820, glazed with a woven hair work locket compartment at the back, length 2.8cm, with a gold neckchain on a cylindrical clasp, length 45cm, and a Victorian pink topaz single stone brooch of filigree and hollow work form, width 2.7cm, fitted with a later safety pin to the back.

Estimate: £150 - £200

### Condition Report

728. Pendant – is in good condition with only a small amount of dirt around the pearls. Weight 4.4g.

Neckchain – showing signs of wear particularly near to the clasp and connecting to the clasp. The chain is perhaps no longer reliable for wearing. Weight 2.5g.

Brooch – has a replacement safety pin at the back so that it can be worn. The original hinge bracket and hook are still present and the safety pin is held into position by a steel pin. It should be possible to convert the brooch to its original condition.

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
