A Rolex Oysterdate Precision steel cased gentleman's wristwatch, the signed jewelled movement numbered '04768', the signed case back interior numbered '6094' and '6294', the signed matt black dial with gilt arrow shaped hour markers, centre seconds and date-of-the-month aperture, numbered between the lugs '883302' and 'Brevet', Rolex crown to winding button, with a Rolex steel Oyster bracelet, with a Rolex Service Division green card box, case diameter 3.4cm.

Dial in generally good clean condition, some typical minor wear and some deterioration to luminous dots. At 12 o'clock between lugs it reads 'Brevet 6294'.

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
